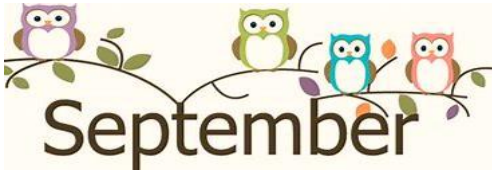

MORNING CAR RIDER DROP OFF

Attendance: Attendance is taken at 10:00 am. Students not present at that time will be marked absent. If your child is absent from school, please send a note with the student's first and last name, teacher's name, date(s) absent, and reason for absence. A doctor's note should be sent for more than 5 consecutive absences.

Late Arrival/Tardies: Students who arrive after 8:45 am are tardy. Parents must come into the front office to sign their child in and students will receive a tardy slip.

A note from our Nurse:

Students may not transport medication to and from school; it must be delivered to the school and picked up by an adult. All medication is to be brought to the clinic in the original container labels with the child's name, name of the medication and directions for the time of dosage. Physician's name must be on prescription medication. Cough drops, vitamins and medicated chap-stick are considered medications and students may not bring those to school.
